RESEARCH ACTIVITY

The research activity project includes 208 published works in the form of abstracts and papers:

- 67 foreign language articles,
- 8 articles in Greek literature,
- 50 chapters of reference books
- 4 published books

Over 330 scientific papers have been presented in international and Greek conferences. In more than 120 papers has been a guest speaker. He was chairman / coordinator roundtable in more than 30 cases. As a supervisor or member of the seven-member tripartite committee helped or help prepare 15 doctoral theses (10 completed, 2 in progress, 3 withdrawn). He received or taking part in 11 research protocols and three funded research projects.

CLINICAL ACTIVITY

The clinical activity includes surgical interventions performed during the period 1995-2003, the position of curator and Assoc. D / Director of Surgical-Vascular Surgery University Hospital of Cologne «Porz am Rhein». The period 2002-2006 private practice in Athens, where he ran over 150 Vascular interventions in various private hospitals (Athens Medical Center, Henry Dunant Hospital, Central Clinic of Athens, etc.) In 2006, he was appointed at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki as an assistant professor and Vascular Surgery joined the First Surgical Clinic (Director: Prof. Rep. Kiskinis). His surgical education includes a total of 17 years (1987-2003) abroad (Germany) and seven years in Greece. In this period Dr. Ktenidis is extensively trained in all diagnostic methods in Angiology, including Doppler sonography, colour-coded Duplex ultrasound and angiography as well. He has deep knowledge in all plethysmographic methods and in capillary microscopy in patients with critical limb ischemia. In surgical work period 1987-2003 included more than 8000 surgeries. His activity in this period is extended to the wider surgical field with focus on Vascular (> 5000 operations). In 2003-2005 (repatriation period, adaptation and waiting my appointment) ran in private hospitals over 100 Vascular surgeries on the aorta, carotid and peripheral arteries. After my appointment as Assistant Professor of Vascular Surgery at AUTH I have taken part in a total of 1587 procedures. In 585 of these served as instructor trainee doctors of our clinic. In other 538 interventions acted as surgeon-assistant next to the teacher-director of A Surgical Clinic Mr. Dimitrios Kiskinis. As an independent surgeon ran 464 Vascular high gravity and high technical difficulty interventions. After my evolution to Associate Professor of Vascular Surgery AUTH 2011 and my membership in 2012 in the 1st Propedeutical Surgery Clinic in AUTH Processing more than 670 vascular surgery or as a surgeon or surgeon as an instructor.
